

Spencer Rifle Cartridge Pack Instructions:

Page 2:

Print as many pages as needed (2 boxes per page) on 110 lbs cardstock, or use the printed pattern on whatever cardstock medium (manila folders, for example) you choose. The lines on the pattern are the folding lines, and should be on the INSIDE of you box as you fold it up. Once you have the box folded, glue down the two long edges where they overlap. Let dry.

Page 3:


Print out as many labels as needed (8 labels per page). Cut them out as close to the black board lines as you can and them glue them to one side of your cartridge packet.

Finishing:

Tuck in one of the closure flaps (you can glue this edge closed as well). Place your 7 cartridges inside the packet, alternating nose and cartridge rim until all 7 are in. Lastly, stand back and enjoy!




